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3.3 Human-readable Summary: How to properly give notice

This section contains human-readable forms of the notices that should be given by you, if you use any of the software contained in the ETACE Virtual Appliance. This follows the licenses that govern the various parts.

3.3.1 Notice for the ETACE Virtual Appliance

If you use the ETACE Virtual Appliance, then according to the ODbL license, you have to give notice in the following way, or in a similar fashion:

”This work contains information from the ETACE Virtual Appliance, which is made available under the Open Database License (ODbL v1.0) (see <http://opendatacommons.org/licenses/odbl/1.0/>), and can be downloaded from: <http://pub.uni-bielefeld.de/data/2674041>.”

3.3.2 Notice for the FLAME libraries

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”This work contains information using the FLAME Xparser and Libmboard library (www.flame.ac.uk), which is made available under the Lesser General Public License (LGPL v3), and can be obtained from: <http://ccpforge.cse.rl.ac.uk/gf/project/xagents/frs/>.”

3.3.3 Notice for the Eurace@Unibi Model Source Code

If you use the Source Code of the Eurace@Unibi Model, then according to the EULA, you have to give notice in the following way, or in a similar fashion:

- Attribution:

”This work uses (a modified version of) the Eurace@Unibi model, developed by Herbert Dawid, Simon Gemkow, Philipp Harting, Sander van der Hoog and Michael Neugart, as an extension of the research within the EU 6th Framework Project Eurace.”

- Notification:

You must notify Herbert Dawid (hdawid@wiwi.uni-bielefeld.de), as representative of the authors, about any publication that contains results derived from the Standard Version or from a Modified Version of the Source Code of the Eurace@Unibi Model.

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
